Dear Parents and Guardians,

On behalf of the Board of Education, we are pleased to present the 2021-22 Quinton Township School District Budget, which will allow us to continue to provide a comprehensive program for the children in our community.

The budget development process encompassed identifying educational priorities, evaluating student, staff and facility needs, and determining the needs of our current and planned programs and services. The Quinton Township School District's Mission Statement includes aspiring to provide every student with access to equal educational opportunities, while maintaining our commitment to a fiscally responsible approach in managing the school district. With this in mind, we created a budget that maintains our existing programs while planning for future needs and improving our facility.

The 2021-22 budget will have an estimated 1.7 cent increase in the tax levy. Here are some highlights of the budget that was presented at the Public Hearing on April 29, 2021:

- Provide and maintain academic programs of study that are in alignment with the Core Curriculum Content Standards and Common Core State Standards.
- Continue support and growth of our students' access to technology with a 1-1 initiative for iPads or Chromebooks (depending on the age of the student)
- Provide academic, social and emotional support services for students and families in need.
- Maintain art, library/computer skills, music, physical education and world language classes.
- Projects to maintain the school facility and provide a safe environment for students and staff.
- Educational services for our students in Grades 9-12.
