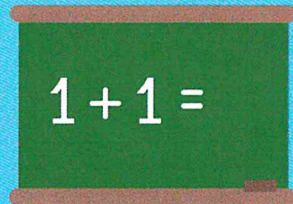


Frequently Asked Questions for Returning to Quinton Township School

We can assure you we have taken every precaution necessary for our students to return safely to school. We will continue to monitor our students, staff, and the situation in the township and county. We are working with all of the necessary officials to ensure we are meeting all guidelines.

Will students switch classrooms?

No, teachers will travel from class to class while students will not move from class to class with the exception of 7th and 8th math and individualized student services.

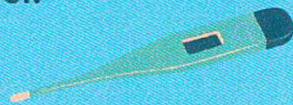


Will time be designated to washing hands?

Yes, the time has been added into the schedule specifically for washing hands after arrival in the morning, before and after lunch and recess. In addition, we have added hand sanitizer stations in the hallways. Students will use their feet to activate the hand sanitizer.

Will temperatures be taken before entering school?

Yes, students, or staff whose temperature is 100.4 or above will not be permitted to attend school. If symptoms of Covid-19 are present, student/staff will be asked to see a doctor.



Will my child have to wear a mask all day?

All students will be required to wear masks inside the school building regardless of social distance unless doing so would inhibit the individual's health.



What about chronic absenteeism?

Everyone is asked to perform a symptom screening prior to leaving for school and must stay home if ill. Students will be able to learn virtually if they must stay home or call out sick.



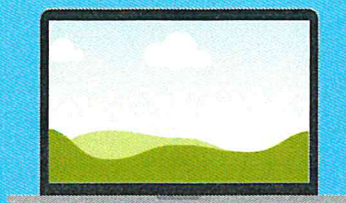
What are the cleaning procedures going to be during the school day?

All high-touch surfaces will be disinfected regularly, including water fountains, door handles, and light switches. Bathrooms will be cleaned hourly. All classrooms in use will be cleaned and disinfected while students are at recess. Students and staff will be encouraged to use individual water bottles from home. Students must bring water bottles filled **ONLY WITH WATER.**



What if I opt to have my child learn virtually until further notice?

Parents/Students will have the option to learn virtually if they do not feel in-person learning is an option. Students will follow their in-school schedule and have access to "live" lessons conducted by their teachers.



Will my child have to wear uniforms?

A school uniform will not be required this year; however, a dress code policy will be in your summer packet.
